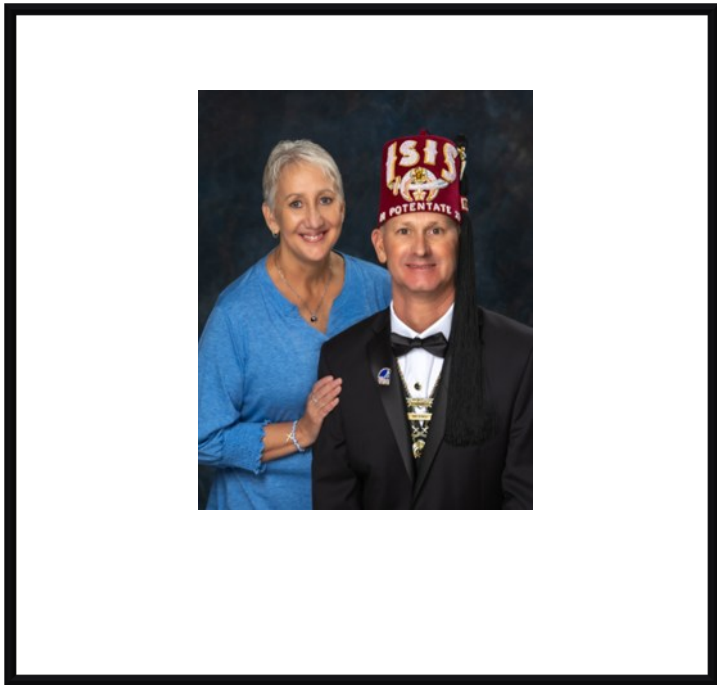

**MESSAGE FROM CHIEF RABBAN:**



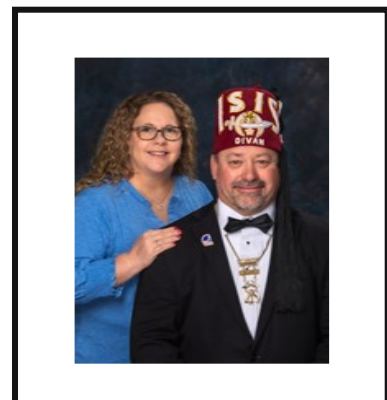
Hello Fellow Nobles,

Nobles and Ladies,

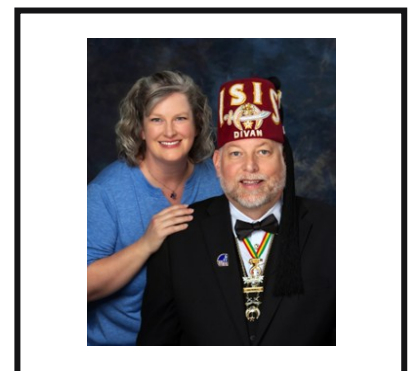

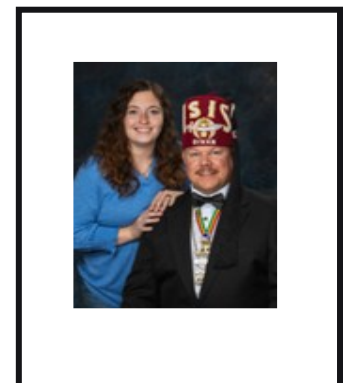

*We believe in the directed, collective efforts of many to reach the beneficial goals of Masonry, Shriners International, and Shriners Hospitals for Children.*

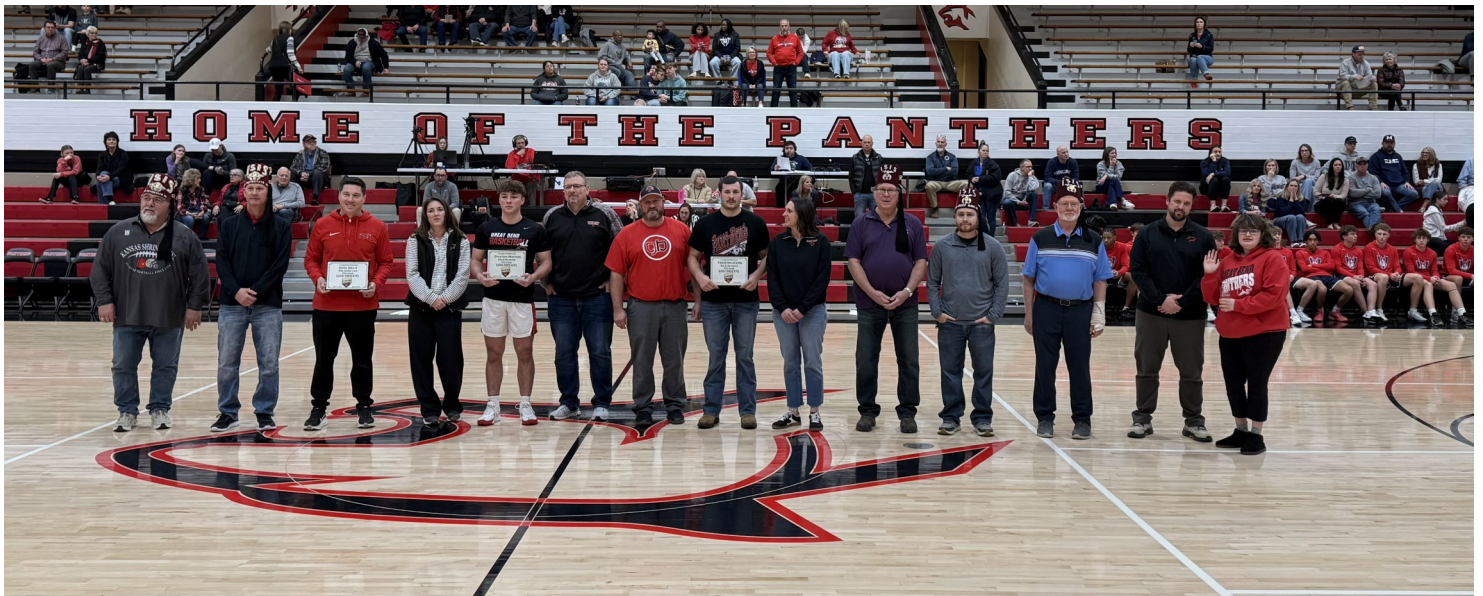
*To that end, we have established the following goals and purposes:*

# The Kansas Shrine Bowl

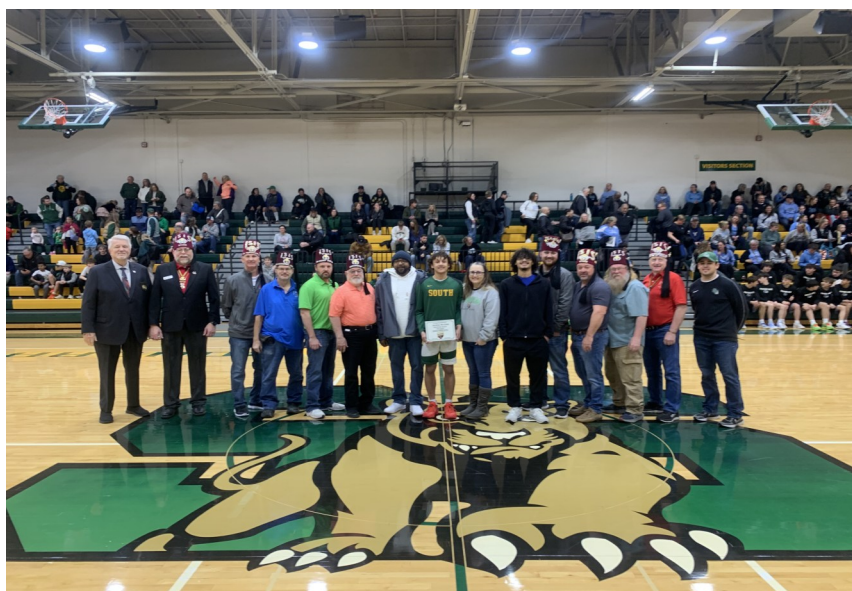

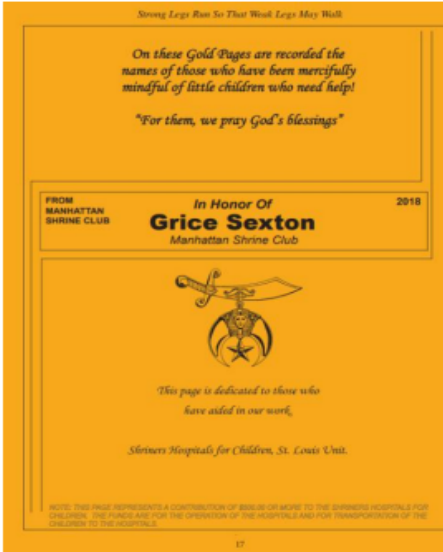

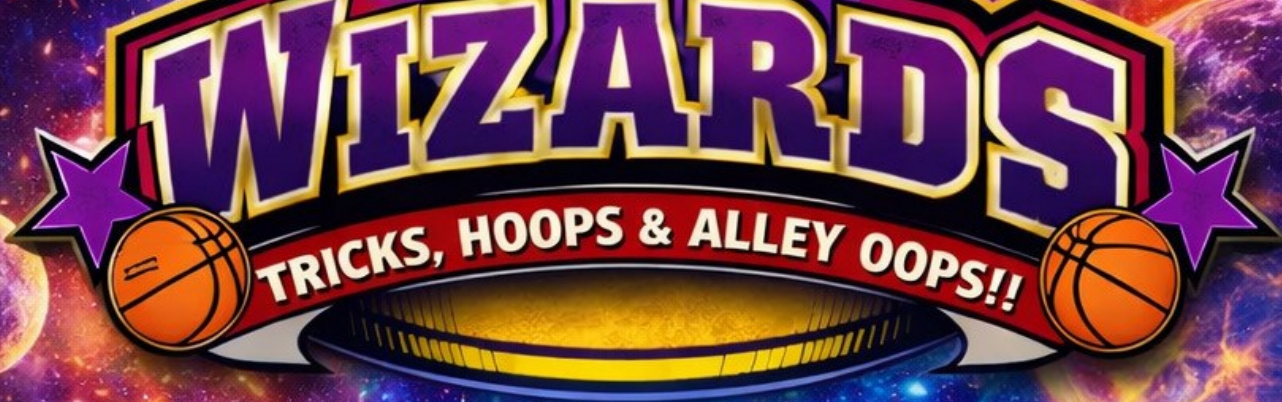
