POTENTATE'S MESSAGE:

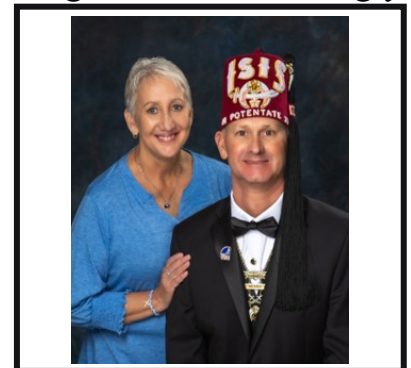
Greetings,

HIGH PREIEST AND PROPHET MESSAGE ABOUT THE SYMBOLISM OF THE ANCIENT GODDESS ISIS LOGO:

Greetings All,

In ancient Egyptian mythology, Isis was one of the most revered and enduring goddesses. She was known as the goddess of motherhood, protection, healing, and magic, and was often depicted with outstretched wings symbolizing shelter and care. Isis was the devoted wife of Osiris and the mother of Horus, and many of the myths surrounding her emphasize her strength, compassion, and determination. She was believed to protect families, guide the dead into the afterlife, and use her wisdom and magical abilities to restore life and bring healing. Because of these qualities, Isis became a symbol of care, nurturing, and guardianship, particularly toward children and the vulnerable.

The symbolism of Isis as a protector and nurturer made her a meaningful inspiration for organizations that value compassion, service, and guardianship. When fraternal organizations began adopting historical and symbolic imagery in the 19th century, the name Isis was embraced by several Shrine temples as a representation of watchful protection and benevolent care. The image of Isis spreading her wings became a powerful visual metaphor for providing comfort, support, and guidance to those in need.

The Shriners International organization is widely known for its commitment to philanthropy, especially through the Shriners Children's network of hospitals and care centers. For more than a century, Shriners have worked to ensure that children with orthopedic conditions, burn injuries, spinal cord injuries, and cleft lip and palate receive specialized medical care regardless of a family's ability to pay. Their hospitals combine advanced medical treatment with compassionate support for children and their families, helping young patients live fuller, healthier lives.

The Isis Shriners, established in 1887, have carried forward this tradition of service for well over a century. Members dedicate their time, resources, and community leadership to supporting the mission of helping children through fundraising, volunteer work, and outreach. Their efforts help provide access to life-changing medical care while also strengthening community bonds through charity events, parades, and educational programs.

From Shriners Children's Patient to Team USA: Salt Lake City Skier Noah Bury Headed to First Winter Paralympics !

Feb 26, 2026 Noah Winter Paralympics 2026 | Shriners Children's

Only 23 years old, former Shriners Children's Salt Lake City patient Noah Bury is headed to the 2026 Milano Cortina Paralympics for his first Winter Games, just three years after competing in para alpine skiing for the first time.

Noah qualified to compete in the slalom at the Winter Games and will be an alternate in the giant slalom and super-G. Although he skied throughout his childhood, Noah wasn't introduced to adaptive skiing until after high school. The Utah native was born with tibial hemimelia and underwent a below-the-knee amputation with Shriners Children's when he was 8 months old. From the time he was born until he turned 21, Noah was a patient at Shriners Children's Salt Lake City.

"I can remember Shriners Children's as the first place I learned to adapt and innovate my approach to life," Noah said. "I had this unique part of me that not many people in the world could relate to. Shriners Children's helped me figure it out and be creative with solutions. I remember creating a foot with my prosthetist for skiing that had never been done before. Shriners Children's played a huge part in my athletic discovery. They never restricted access to anything. They made me lots of prosthetics that I could use for all my activities."

Noah felt a combination of exhilaration and relief when he found out he made Team USA for the Winter Paralympics. The 23-year-old even teared up after receiving the call. In just a few short years, Noah pushed himself from someone who had never competed in para alpine to making the pinnacle event of his sport. He encouraged other Shriners Children's patients to push their boundaries.
